A look into the life of...

Dear Friends,
I felt an enormous pressure on me that made it impossible for me to eat. One member of our band was warned by some punks he met on the street. "Don't go to Madame Satan, they will kill you there," they said.

Madame Satan is located in an area like Harlem in New York City. Except in Sac Paulo, Brazil there are 50
murders every weekend and the police wear bulletproof vests. Madame Satan is the most famous Goth club in Sac Paula, an enormous city of 18 million people.

My ears hurt and I cried in the shower because I was feeling so much emotion. As I prepared myself to go to Madame Satan I kept hearing crazy scenarios in my head. "Was I testing God by going back to this club?" "Was I putting my band at risk"?
the spiritual darkness was so heavy in the club you could taste it but this year I could feel God's presence all around me and so could everyone else.

When we started to play we felt a total authority and the audience was captivated. In our concert we show how a girl is abused and I (representing Jesus) carry her to the front of the stage. When I picked her up I felt the weight of God's broken heart and I started to weep as I held the girl. The power of God was everywhere. It was so intense. So strong. Some people began to cry in the club.

Later in the concert when I came out of a coffin to show how Jesus rose from the dead, the Holy Spirit filled the place. It was almost liquid it was so tangible. No one could deny it. There was no resistance and no mocking, a total break through! "My friends have to see this." Some of them said out loud. Several said that they felt a different spirit there. One they never felt before. Sandro asked them what kind of spirit they felt. They said it was "Love."

People rushed us for Bibles and we quickly ran out.
Throughout the club people were crying and hugging. The owner of the club asked if he could speak with me. Last year he was very aggressive and hostile but he was
completely humble this year. "Thank you so much for coming." He said as he held my hand. I could see the look in his eyes that God was touching him deeply. "Can I pray for you?" I asked He nodded his head. So I put my hand on his chest and prayed for him. The owner of Madame Satan!!!!! The most influential and notorious underground Goth club in Sap Paula. This is unbelievably amazing.

It has been my experience that it is more difficult the second time you back into a heavy club. The last time we were at Madame Satan it was so intense that Sandra (the Brazilian pastor we work with) feared we would die. Some people who organized the concert even refused to enter the club they were so afraid. How could it be more heavy? I tried not to think about it. I felt like Satan was blasting my mind and emotions with insecurity and fear. We had made our decision and we weren't going to back down now.

When I entered the club it was packed with typical Goths. The cellar where we would play was totally dark except for he one slow flashing strobe light. Last year




Picture yourself coming home to an early $20^{\text {th }}$ Century Victorian house. You live just outside of town and have a few acres of oak woodland surrounding your simple home, protecting your family from the insomniatic buzz of city life. Work is tough at the office and the hours pile up, but it's a small price to pay for a comfortable, secure home. Pulling into your driveway, you look upon your kids as they are busily building a tree fort and then you fix your eyes toward your loving spouse. You are greeted with a smile and quickly return the gesture. This weekend is going to be great. You plan to take the boat out on the lake, kick back, and enjoy life. Ah, certainly this is the American Dream. I mean, this is the age where a good, hard-working, "Christian" lifestyle and comfortable family living meet in tranquility... right? Wasn't this God's intention for us all along?
I mean, if there weren't any "bennies" to this whole Christian gig, what would be the point? We already have to give up over an hour on Sundays to maintain our membership at the local chapel.

We are required to pray before meals, give our money to organizations like "The United Way," and flash a plastic smile toward everyone that stumbles onto our path. Is it really too much to ask for a caring spouse, a couple of kids, and a quaint little home in the country?

But what if doing all these things for God didn't give us the payback we were looking for?
 What if our life actually became more difficult as we invested more and more time in this whole church thing? Would we still be interested? We have to ask ourselves that question because we don't read much about a comfortable Christian life in the early writings about Jesus. Instead, we read the opposite. Jesus said, "If you try to keep your life for yourself, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for me (Jesus), you will find true life (Matt. 16:25)." Later, we read "everyone who wants to live a Godly life in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution ${ }_{(2 \text { Tim. } 3: 12) \text {." }}$ Yikes, that doesn't really groove with the whole white-picket fence, three-car garage kind of family living of today. Certain writings regarding
marriage tell us "the person that marries does well, and the person who doesn't marry does even better ${ }_{(1 \text { cor } .7: 38)}$ " and that "the time that remains is short, so husbands should not let marriage be their major concern ${ }_{(1 \text { cor. 7:29)." }}$. So the first verse hits the singles and the second verse hits the people that are already married. Now is this saying that marriage is bad? Not at all. The point is, married or not, Jesus is to be our primary concern.

Why would anybody dedicate themselves to a life where they give up the things they want to do and then not get the "loot" in return? To answer that question we must first ask ourselves if we are ever really satisfied by this life in the first place. The whole "Leave it to Beaver" family portrait seems nice and all, but is our longing for that a good thing? Or would that desire just be another drug, like alcohol or sex, that never completely satisfies us? When we stop to think about it, it seems like nothing we chase after gives us
lasting contentment. Usually we end up either wanting more of what we have or wanting something else entirely.

Right about now you may be thinking "what does Jesus have to do with all of this?" Jesus says some pretty specific stuff about this world and our contentment. He claims that He can give us a peace that goes beyond that of a relaxing weekend on the lake ${ }_{\text {(Phil. 4:7) }}$.. and that His love is broader and deeper than any spouse or family can give ${ }_{(E \mathrm{Eph}}$ 3:14-21). He then goes on to say that when we die, He will take those who trust in Him to a perfect home ${ }_{(\text {John 14:2-3) }}$, far better than any home or family that we could dream of here. Certainly these promises are bold and seem illogical, but could they be true? Only one person has the authority to answer that question. This person is Jesus and He can be found in the Bible. He already knows you and He is waiting and eager to be known by you.

question the reliability of these drawers supposed answers, but I didn't know where else to look so I desperately returned to the dresser. I peered into the fourth drawer and, behold, it contained a pornographic magazine. It suddenly seemed obvious to give up on the love aspect of relationships for surely the sexual binding of the flesh would heal me more efficiently. Therefore, whomever I had the most remote interest in would become another person I gave myself to. The magic of this technique quickly wore off and, as all of the others, it failed to fill the ever-deepening hole. I decided to give up on searching any new drawers for a while. and as life went on I began mixing all the drawers' answers together until the hole began to consume the majority of my lifeless heart. I became numb to all emotion and lost all concept of what was right and wrong. I often got the sneaking suspicion that death was the only solution to my unfulfilled heart.

I was reaching my end, so I decided to search the fifth drawer to see if it would offer any better solutions. Not knowing what to expect. I opened the drawer and it contained a small statue of the Virgin Mary. I thought it seemed out there, but maybe religion was the answer. I decided to go to the Catholic church my parents used to take me to. As I listened to the sermon, every word that came out of the priest's mouth made me feel worse and worse. It was cultic and condemning. By the time I left, I knew that because of how I looked and all the horrible things I'd done, no God (if there was a God) would ever accept me. I was doomed for hell, and completely lost all hope. I'd tried numerous drugs, self-abuse, love, sex, and religion; there was nothing else for me to try.

## A Brief History of Design

 By Russell GriggFirst published in: Creation Ex Nihilo 22(2):50-53 March-May 2000

For over two millennia, people have argued that the 'design' in nature points to a Designer. ${ }^{1}$ In 44 BC , the Roman writer, orator, and statesman, Cicero ( $106-43 \mathrm{BC}$ ), used this concept in his book De Natura Deorum (On the Nature of the Gods) ${ }^{2}$ to challenge the evolutionary ideas of the philosophers of his day.

## Greek evolutionism, the gods, and fear of death

The two main schools of philosophy then were Epicureanism ${ }^{3}$ and Stoicism. ${ }^{4}$ The Epicureans sought happiness through bodily pleasures and freedom from pain and anxiety. The two chief causes of anxiety were fear of the gods and fear of death, so Epicurus sought to nullify both of these by teaching an evolutionary atomic theory. ${ }^{5}$ He denied that there was any purpose in nature because everything was composed of particles (atoma: atoms), all falling downwards. He said that these sometimes spontaneously 'swerved' to
 coalesce and form bodies-nonliving, living, human, and divine. ${ }^{6}$ The gods were made of finer atoms than humankind. They did not create the world or have any control over it, so they were not concerned with human affairs, and there was therefore no need for man to fear them. At death, the soul disintegrated and became non-existent, so there was no need to fear death or the prospect of judgment after death. Cicero used the Stoic character in his book to refute these ideas with arguments from design, aimed to show that the universe is governed by an intelligent designer. He argued that a conscious purpose was needed to express art (e.g. to make a
picture or a statue) and so, because nature was more perfect than art, nature showed purposed also. Cicero continued his challenge to the evolutionism of Epicurus by marveling that anyone could persuade himself that chance collisions of particles could form anything as beautiful as the worid. He said that this was on par with believing that if the letters of the alphabet were thrown on the ground often enough they would spell out the Annals of Ennius. ${ }^{7.8} \mathrm{He}$ asked: if chance collisions of particles could make a world, then why cannot they build much less difficult objects, like a colonnade, a temple, a house, or a city? ${ }^{9}$

## More Recent users of the design argument

In the 18th century, the most notable user of the design argument was Wiliam Paley (1743-1805). In his book, Natural Theology, he put the case of someone finding a watch while walking in a barren countryside. From the functions which the various parts of the watch fulfill (e.g. spring, gear-wheels, pointer), the only logical conclusion was that it had a maker who 'comprehended its construction and designed its use'. ${ }^{10}$ Paley also discussed evidence of design in the eye-that as an instrument for vision it showed intelligent design in the same way that telescopes,
microscopes and spectacles do. He went on to discuss complex design in many other human and animal organs, all pointing to the conclusion that the existence of complex life implies an intelligent Creator.

David Hume, the 18th century Scottish sceptical philosopher, tried to counter the watch argument by pointing out that watches are not living things which reproduce. However,
Paley wrote 30 years after Hume, and Paley's arguments are proof against most of Hume's objections. For example, a modern philosopher has countered Hume: 'Paley's argument about organisms stands on its own, regardless of design rather whether watches and organisms happen to be similar. The point of talking about

watches is to help the reader see that the argument about organisms is compelling.' ${ }^{11}$

## Charles Darwin and Paley

Charles Darwin was required to read Paley during his theological studies at Cambridge (1828-31). He later said, 'I do not think that I hardly ever admired a book more than Paley's "Natural Theology." | could almost formerly have said it by heart. ${ }^{12}$ However, he then spent the rest of his life developing and promoting a theory to explain how 'design' in nature could occur without God. ${ }^{13}$ Darwin proposed that small, useful changes could occur by chance, and enable their possessors to survive and pass on these changes-natural selection. Natural selection would work on even the tiniest improvements and, over vast ages, would supposedly accumulate enough small changes to produce all the 'design' we see in the living world.

## Modern science vs Darwin

 Evolutionists, including the stridently atheistic Oxford Professor Richard Dawkins, still use Darwin's theory to oppose the design argument. But now, they believe that natural selection acts on genetic copying mistakes (mutations), some of which are supposed to increase the genetic information content. But Dawkins' arguments have been severely critiqued on scientific grounds. ${ }^{14,15,16,17}$Dawkins' neo-Darwinism has several flaws: 1) Natural selection requires self reproducing entities. Producing even the simplest self-reproducing organism by a chance combination of chemicals is even more incredible than producing the Annals of Ennius by dropping letters on the ground. Living things require long molecules with precise arrangements of smaller 'building blocks'. Not only will the 'building blocks' not combine in the right order, but they are unlikely, by natural means, to build up large molecules at all! Rather, large molecules tend to break down into smaller ones. ${ }^{18}$ Also, the 'building blocks' are unstable. ${ }^{19} 2$ ) There is complex biological machinery of which Darwin was simply ignorant. Biochemist Dr Michael Behe lists a
number of examples: real motors, transport systems, the blood clotting cascade, the complex visual machinery. He argues that they require many parts or they would not function at all, so they could not have been built in small steps by natural selection..$^{20} 3$ ) Biophysicist/information theorist Dr. Lee Spetner points out that mutations never add information, but only reduce it-this includes even the rare helpful mutations. And he points out that natural selection is insufficient to accumulate slight advantages, as it would be too weak to overcome the effects of chance, which would tend to eliminate these mutants. ${ }^{21}$

## The Bible and the 'design argument'

The Apostle Paul used the design argument in Romans 1:20 (i.e. evidences of design in nature). And he says that because of this, the ungodly are 'without excuse'. But Paul continues that the people willingly reject this clear evidence. This evidence of design in nature is enough to condemn men, but it is not enough to save them. The Bible makes it clear that the preaching of the Gospel is also needed to show how we are to come into a right relationship with the Creator (see next section). ${ }^{22}$ Cicero lived in the century before Christ and probably had never heard of the Gospel of Genesis; he used design in support of the Greek pantheon of gods and goddesses of the Stoics. Today, 'New Agers' may attribute design to Mother Nature of Gaia (the Greek goddess of the earth).


## Creation Evangelism

When Christians use design and other arguments from science, they are properly engaging in pre-evangelism, i. e. they are seeking to expose the fallacy of the evolutionary presuppositions that blind the eyes of people today to the truth of the Word of God. This is shown by the Apostle Paul's experience in Athens. Paul 'preached Jesus and the resurrection' (Acts 17:18), which challenged both the Epicurean and the Stoic philosophers of his day-i.e. both Cicero's opponents and his fellow believers. Paul challenged their faulty ideas by pointing them to the one true God who had created everything. But

Paul didn't stop with creation. ${ }^{23} \mathrm{He}$ urged them to repent, and he said they could know there would be a Day of Judgment because God had appointed the Judge and given assurance of this by raising Him from the dead (Acts 17:18-31).

The only way to be saved is to believe in the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ (Acts 4:12), the Creator/Redeemer, who died and rose again to pay the penalty for mankind's $\sin$. We should follow the way Paul presented the Gospel in 1Cor. 15- N.B. verses 1-4, 21-22, 26, 45, which make sense only with literal Genesis-a literal Creation, Fall, death penalty for sin, etc. John the Evangelist wrote his Gospel 'so that

Gitt, W., Dazzling Design in Miniature, Creation 20(1):6, 1997 you might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that, believing, you might have life in His name' (John 20:31). But he began his Gospel by declaring that Jesus is the Creator (John 1:1-3), the Second Person of the Trinity, who took on human nature (John 1:14). Thus evangelism must present Christ as Creator or it is deficient-if Christ is not God, then He cannot be our Savior (Isaiah 43:11).

## Conclusion

Without the message of design and the creator, 'gospel preaching' lacks foundation. Without Christ, the design argument cannot save. We must present a full Gospel, starting with creation by the Triune God, and combine it with the message of Christ's death for $\sin$ and His Resurrection.

Three hour blocks of time are available for volunteers (church, community, college, and school groups, as well as individuals) to come and package food. Volunteers are quickly trained in various positions of pouring ingredients weighing, sealing, and boxing. In a fun environment, volunteers interact with each other while doing something practical to make a difference in our world.

I grew up in a village in Bihar together with my little sister, my brother,
and an older stepbrother. My parents had to work very hard In the fields. They gave us love and security; but one day they became very sick. I was crying and worrying, wanting them to get well again. I felt so much sadness, seeing how they got skinnier every day.
First my father died, then twenty-four hours later, my mother. My stepbrother took me out of school in second grade; 1 had to work in a tea stall to earn money. I didn't receive any love from my stepbrother and his wife. These were lonely, sad days for me, I missed my parents. I never felt any joy that time.
One evening, after my stepbrother hacd beat me again, I just left my village. It was an impulse that I hopped on a train to Delhi without a ticket; without any money. I was hungry for two days. I couldn't work because my body was too weak. Somebody told me that I could get food at the Hanuman temple. I went there and after seven days every part of my body was infected, I couldn't open my mouth, my eyes were red, I surely would have died if Baba hadn't found me sitting at the temple.
He asked me if I wanted to come to his house. I said "Yes". I stayed at Delhi House and within 3 months I was healthy again. I never thought that I would be able to go back to school because I missed so many years. But, now I understand that it is a miracle of Jesus that l'm studying and everything is going well. I learned English in one year, could skip two grades, and l'm in a higher standard school now.
I know that because of Jesus I have a better life now. His love will be with me forever: He gives me what I need. I want to go to college and in the future I aiso
father is a dri family. My drver with the to gradet. went to school up starte and take drugs like hash and then smack. I got a job with a large company working in the storage area. I was getting good money but just would spend it all on drugs. I got involved in crime that led me one day to kill somebody. So, I ran to the city of Delhi to escape punishment.
As soon as I got to Delhi, I met a guy who was taking some smack. I got him to hook me up, and for the next month 1 stayed completely wasted out of my head.
One day, in a drug induced stupor, I wandered onto the highway and a truck hit me head on. It tore my chest open, and I flew backwards onto cement and gravel. My whole back was full of stones. A guy came to help me but ended up just taking all my money and he left.
The police arrived and took me to hospital where they pulled all the stones out of my back and gave me a bed. I had to get drugs so I ran away. Back on the street ! only cared about getting drugs so became very dirty and all my wounds got infected.
That is when I met Baba. He took me back to the hospital where I got my wounds cleaned Because I had run away already they would not admit me. So, a friend helped me to go to Baba's place. I don't know how I have been so changed. Since coming here, I have not had any desire for drugs on which for ten years i did depend. My wounds are almost all healed. I have a peace in me that I never had before.

The Nonnegotiable Gospel

"Go you into all the worid, and preach the gospel. for II is the power of God unta salvation to every one that believes (II). Mark 15:5: Romans 1:16

What is the gospel and from what does it save us?

We must begin in the Garden. Persuaded by Satan that God had lied to her, and seduced by the appealing promise of godhood,

Then He would rise from the dead to live in those who would believe in and receive Him as their Lord and Saviar, giving them forgiveness of sins and eternal life as a free gift of $H$ is grace.

Centuries before his incarnation, God inspired the DId Testament prophets to declare His eternal and unchangeable plan of salvation. Definitive criteria were provided by which the coming Savior would be identified. Jesus and His apostles did not invent a "new religion." Christianity fulfills scores of specific prophecies and is thus provable from scripture!
fact abundantly clear. To reject or add or to take from ar otherwise pervert or embrace a substitute for "the gospel of Gad" is to perpetuate the rebellion begun by Adam and Eve and to leave one eternally separated from Eod under His wrath. No wonder Paul wrote, "Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade man..." (2Cor 5:ll) So we must persuade through the gospel!

The "gospel of your salvation" (Eph: 13) "where in you stand; by which you are saved" (| Cor 15:1-2) is simple and precise, leaving no room for misunderstanding or negotiation: "that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures: that he was buried, and rose again the third day..." (vv 34). This "everlasting gospel" (Rv 14:6) was promised "before the warld began" (2 Tim 1:9:Ti 1:2) and cannot be changed with time or culture. There is no other hope for mankind, no other way to be forgiven and brought back to God except through this "strait gate and narrow way." (Mt 7:13) Any broader road leads to destruction. (v/3)

The one true "gospel of Cod's grace," which Fod offers as our only salvation has three basic elements: 1) Wha Christ is-fully God and perfect, sinless man in one person (where if He were less He could not be our Savior); 2) who we are-hopeless sinners already condemned to eternal death (or we wouldn't need to be saved); 3) what Christ's death accomplishedthe payment of the full penalty for our sins (any attempt by us to pay in any way rejects the Cross).

Then He wauld rise from the dead to live in thase who wald belize in and receive lim as their Lord and Savior, giving then forgiveness of sins and eternal lite as a frea git of fis grase

Eve rebelled against her Creator. Not wanting to be So it was not a new gospel which Paul preached, separated from his wife, whom he loved more than God, Adam who was not decaived (Tim 2:14), deliberately joined in her disobedience. Thus "by one man (Adam) sin entered into the world, and death by sin: and sa death passed upon all men (and women), for that all have sinned" (Rom 5:12). Death not only ends this shart earthly life, but it separates the sinner from Sod farever.

In His infinita foreknowiedge, wisdom, and love, God already planned what He would do to reunite mankind with Himself. Without ceasing to be God (an impossibility), He would become a man through virgin birth: Only God could be the Savior (Is 43:11: $45: 21 ; \mathrm{Til}: 3 \mathrm{~B}-4$, etc). He would die for our sins to pay the penalty demanded by His justice: "Tis mystery all, the immortal dies!" (Charles Wesley).
but "the gospel of God." (which He had promised afore by his praphets in the holy scriptures) concerning his Son Jesus Christ..." (Rom I:-3). Thus the Bereans could check Paul's message against the Old Testament (Acts 17:11); and he could use the Hebrew prophets, which read in the synagogue each Sabbath, to show that Jesus was the promised Messiah (yv2-3). Not Buddha, not Muhammad, not any one else-only Jesus Christ has the required credentials! The fulfillment of scores of specific praphecies in the life, death. and resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth is absolute proof that He is the true and only Savior.

In Hebrews $2: 3$ the vital question is asked, "how shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation?" There is no escape. The Bible makes that solemn

Christ has commanded us to "preach the gospel (good news!) to every creature (person) (Mk 16:15). What response is required? Both the desperate question and uncomplicated answer are given to us: "What must I do to be saved? Believe on the Lard Jesus Christ, and thou will be saved" (Acts 16:30-31). Neither religion, ritual, not good works will avail-simply believe. "For by grace we are saved through faith" (Eph 28)whosoever believes in Him will not die, but has eternal life (Jn 3:15).
It is the gospel alone that saves those who believe it. Nothing else will save (you).

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Got Peace? Most people don't. Most say that they try to make peace or be peaceful, but they don't really have peace for themselves. They find themselves anxious, worried nervous, scared, or generally just always trying to find the right thing, person, or place to satisfy them. What if there was a peace personthis coming from, and available to you that you didn't control? When you just can't take have to search for earn or seek it anymore, and you just want after? What if there was a peace that would come right to you? A peace that would never run out. I'm not talking about the wimpy peace that is just the absence of problems, wars, troubles, trials, and anxieties. I'm talking about real peace that comes to you in the middle of trials, anxiety, and wars, bringing calm during your deepest anxieties. Whether you are poor and alone in a desert or on a tropical vacation with your friends, the peace remains.
Philippians 4:6-7 "Don't worry about anything; instead pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all that he has done. If you do this, you will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus."

This type of peace doesn't come through knowledge or through understanding. It is commonly thought that if you can just
understand what is going on or where the other person is coming from then there won't be quarrels and strife. Maybe.
But what about the times when it doesn't make sense and you can't understand why you are so full of nervousness and worry? When you don't know where the other person is coming from, and control? When you just can't take peace?
There is a peace that will blow your mind. A peace that is so supernatural that it is beyond your understanding it and how it works. A peace that will rule over everything in your heart. It is the peace of God.
Isaiah 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in You, whose thoughts are fixed on You!"
Only God can give supernatural peace because He is a supernatural God. His peace is not of this world, because He is not of this world. He knows that in this world you will have trials, wars, anxieties, and storms. That's why He gives peace that overcomes these things.
